Right now, you are juggling everything from college applications, SATs and ACTs, to prom, college essays, a part time job, AP and IB exams, dual enrollment and the inability to get sleep along with constantly being asked “so what are you going to do next year?” You have worked towards graduation day for thirteen years. Slow down and enjoy your accomplishment.

Present -March 13,2019

Graduation Fee – (this fee includes payment for your cap, gown, tassel, class pin, diploma and cover). You may pay online with a credit or debit card or with cash or check to the activities office. Make checks payable to Spruce Creek High School for \$80.00. Graduation fees not paid before March 14th will increase to \$85.00. You must have your receipt to pick up your cap and gown. Take a picture of it or keep it someplace safe.

February 4-8, 2019

Grad Bash Tickets on Sale - See Mrs. Rocco in the Activities Office before or after school or during lunch to purchase your Grad Bash Ticket. Tickets will only be sold on these five days, or until they are sold out. The cost is \$115 and includes admission and charter bus transportation. Grad Bash Night is April 12, 2019 (annual passes for Universal Studios/ Islands of Adventure are not valid for Grad Bash).

April 2, 2019

Senior Speaker try-outs – At 3:00pm (location TBA). One senior is chosen to give a speech (2 minutes) at the graduation ceremony. Sign up in advance in the Activities Office.

April 2-5, 2019

Cap & Gown Delivery Days – Caps & gowns will be distributed to those who have paid their Graduation fee. Announcements and other graduation supplies ordered will be distributed by Jostens.

May 29, 2019

Senior Farewell Breakfast- 8am at Spruce Creek High School.

Seniors are invited to a catered breakfast (free of charge). You will have the opportunity to pay any outstanding obligations, pick up honor cords or awards that may have been distributed the night before at the awards program and the final chance to pick up a cap and gown packet.

June 2, 2019

Graduation Ceremony - will be held at the Ocean Center at **3:30PM**. Seniors should report to their assigned area at the Ocean Center by 2:30PM, dressed in cap and gown, to line up for the processional. The graduation ceremony last approximately 90 minutes. Diplomas will be distributed after the ceremony to those graduates not owing an obligation to the school.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ATTENDING GRADUATION

- Each ticket holder, including children, may carry an approved clear bag and a clutch purse:
One clear bag no larger than 12"x 6"x 12" or a one-gallon clear Ziploc, or similar bag.
One small clutch bag or purse no larger than 6.5"x 6.5", with or without a strap.
- Diapers and wipes may be carried in a clear bag; however, diaper bags are not permitted.
- Additional clothing, blankets, etc. are permitted if carried loosely (preferably over the shoulder to be screened more quickly) or in an approved clear bag.
- Small cameras, binoculars and cell phones may be carried loosely or in an approved clear bag.

Parking for graduation is available at the Ocean Center and surrounding parking lots. Guests will pay \$5.00 to park. Carpooling is HIGHLY recommended. All seniors and guests are asked to plan accordingly so that you arrive on time for Graduation. Doors will close at 3:30PM and guests will not be admitted until after the graduates have entered the Ocean Center and the ceremony has begun.
