AGREEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

I have read, understand and agree to the following:

1. All of the STUDENT INFORMATION is true and correct.
2. Student is requesting entrance into the academy of choice checked on the next page.
3. If the academy of choice requires the student to attend an **OUT-OF-ZONE HIGH SCHOOL**:
 - a. 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students must be able to complete the core and CTE program associated with the academy program of study.
 - b. Students wishing to transfer to another academy at a school different from the school they are currently attending, and that new school is not their zoned school, must comply with Policy 203, Attendance Areas for Students, Section III. This section shall require interviews with the student and parents/guardians by the principal of both the sending school and receiving school and all other applicable variance requirements.
 - c. The student should contact the out-of-zone school to determine if bus transportation is available. *See school for approved transportation list.*
 - d. ALL academies (east and west) are open to the student who can provide his/her own transportation.
 - e. Out-of-zone students who leave the academy must return to their home school.
4. Admission into an academy of choice requires the student to complete this *District Career Academy Application* for each academy of choice even when academies of choice are located at the SAME school.
5. Each completed district application to an academy of choice must be returned to the school by **April 30, 2010** (*contact and address information on page 2*). Priority is given to district applications turned in by the deadline.
6. District applications that are incomplete are reviewed based on information received by the due date.
7. Student eligibility may be determined by such factors as academic performance, attendance, and conduct.
8. When the number of qualified student applicants to an academy of choice exceeds the number of available positions, a random selection process (lottery) is utilized to accept qualified applicants.
9. If the student is not accepted into an academy of choice this year, the student must reapply next year, if interested.
