for students who will take Biology 1 next school year. This is an interactive experience that concludes with students visiting the outside classroom located at Rose Bay.

(Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, and US History) that you have **not taken or passed**.

Plan to be on campus no later than 1:00 PM, for your assigned orientation group. You should report to the auditorium upon arrival.

Parents, freshmen orientation is designed to build confidence and develop a sense of familiarity for our newest Hawks. The program is approximately 2 ½ hours long. You are encouraged to drop students off and return around 3:30 pm for pick up. If you are attending orientation in place of your student, please note that you will be assigned to a group as your child. You will need to follow the timeline of that group or you may come at 3:30pm on your assigned day to pick up schedules, visit the cashier and be assigned a locker for your freshman.

**CSALT** (Creek Student Ambassadors and Leadership Team) will guide incoming freshmen through the orientation process. Students will tour the school, have their picture taken for their Student ID, pick up their bus route information (if available), proposed class schedule and visit the cashier to purchase the items below, during their tours. All items listed are optional with the exception of Freshmen SGA class dues.

Please bring receipt to orientation in order to pick up items purchased online.

Photos will be taken for Student ID's at Orientation, and the ID cards will be distributed during the first week of school. There is **no charge** for the first ID card, however, replacement ID cards are \$10.00.

If you are unable to attend orientation at your designated day and time, you will be able to purchase items during the first week of school. Friends may not purchase items for you in your absence. **The above dates provide the only orientation opportunity students have before school begins. Please plan on attending at your correct time only, based on the first letter of your last name. We will not have your schedule or information available until your scheduled orientation time.**

As you know, the District made modifications to the student dress code last year. All current aspects of the dress code remain in effect. Students are to wear a white, orange, grey or black collared **polo-style shirt or oxford style button down shirt (no lace-up or drawstring closures)**. The pants, shorts, capris, skorts, or jumper are to be **navy blue, black or tan** (khaki). Black and blue denim (jeans) **long pants** are also acceptable. No rips tears, holes or frayed edges are permitted on any garments. **More detailed information** regarding the dress code is available on the school's or district's website.

One final note: A 2017-2018 student planner/agenda will be provided for freshmen students. These will be handed out within the first week of school during English class. There is no need to purchase one.
