available to students who need to make-up a failed course
- **Algebra EOC: July 5- July 20, 8:00AM to 11:30AM**
for students who have not passed the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement
- **Biology Jump Start: July 10 – July 19, 8:30AM to 11:30AM**
for students who will take Biology 1 next school year. This is an interactive experience that concludes with students visiting the outside classroom located at Rose Bay.
- **Take an EOC: July 17- July 20. Please Call Mrs. Harnage at extension 37807 to sign up.**
(Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, and US History) that you have **not taken or passed.**

Orientation for the 2017- 2018 school year is quickly approaching. This is an opportunity to purchase lockers, parking decals, and have your ID photo taken (if not previously taken or if ID was lost) before school starts. All students are encouraged to attend according to the dates assigned to each grade level below.

Orientation is scheduled as follows, so please mark your calendars now:

Seniors -	Thursday	July	27	8 AM
Juniors -	Wednesday	August	2	8 AM
Sophomores -	Thursday	August	3	8 AM

Park in the student parking lot and enter the Auditorium. Tickets will be distributed beginning at 7am on your respective date. Students are called by ticket number (first come, first serve) to start the orientation process. This may take up to 3 hours.

Please remember, **if you are unable to attend on your assigned date, the items may be purchased the first week of school. Friends may not purchase items for you in your absence. Parents or another adult with written permission may attend orientation on your behalf, however no exception to protocol will be considered. If they are unable to stay for the duration of orientation (potential 3 hour wait), it is recommended that you procure your items the first week of school.**

Payment for the items listed below, may be made by cash or check payable to Spruce Creek High School or online at the school web store with a credit or debit card (transaction fee will apply) at www.sprucecreekhigh.com
Please bring receipt to orientation in order to pick up items purchased online.

Lockers: **\$10.00**

Parking Decals: **\$45.00** To qualify for a parking permit, student must have and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA throughout the school year with no discipline or attendance issues, and have no obligations.

The student must bring a valid driver's license, current vehicle registration card in the driver's or vehicle owner's name and valid proof of insurance when purchasing the parking permit. Online application must be completed prior to decal purchase.

Class Dues: Seniors - **\$ 10.00** (includes class T-shirt)
Juniors - **\$ 10.00** (includes class T-shirt)
Sophomores - **\$ 5.00** (includes class T-shirt)

Student Athletic Pass: **\$40.00** Valid for admission to all regular season home sporting events for the 2017-2018 year. It does NOT cover away games, district, regional or state competitions.

Uniform Polos: **\$10.00** All four colors available

Yearbook: **\$80.00** You may purchase your yearbook at discounted price at orientation.

*** Obligations: Avoid delays in getting your parking pass! If you have obligations, please pay them NOW, over the summer—stop by the main office, Monday – Thursday between 8AM and 4PM (closed noon-1pm)**

Spruce Creek High School ID photos will be taken during orientation and distributed when you receive your textbooks during the first week of school. If you are a new student, or have never had an ID made, your first ID is free. Replacement ID's are \$10.

Seniors that would like to leave campus for lunch during the school year, must have completed, signed and approved paperwork submitted, before ID will be made. The paperwork can be downloaded from the school website (look under students tab and then under forms).

SENIORS – The official photographer for Spruce Creek High is **Dean Stewart Photography (DSP)**, and only photographs taken by DSP will appear in the yearbook. DSP has a local photography studio at **4606 Clyde Morris Blvd. Ste 2K, Port Orange (Ravenwood Plaza)**. Appointments should be set up at the DSP website, www.dsp-photo.com by clicking on "Class of 2018" and choosing their Daytona Studio for Formal Portraits. There is an \$11 processing fee payable at the time of sitting. Seniors will need to book their formal photo-shoot as quickly as possible, and **should have this completed prior to Orientation.**

Underclassmen picture day is September 26, 2017 (make-up date is November 2, 2017). Only those who have their picture taken will appear in the yearbook.

As you know, the District made modifications to the student dress code last year. All current aspects of the dress code remain in effect. Students are to wear a white, orange, grey or black collared **polo-style shirt** or **oxford style button down shirt (no lace-up or drawstring closures)**. The pants, shorts, capris, skorts, or jumper are to be **navy blue, black or tan** (khaki). Black and blue denim (jeans) **long pants** are also acceptable. No rips tears, holes or frayed edges are permitted on any garments. **More detailed information** regarding the dress code is available on the school's or district's website.
