

## Volusia County Schools Dress Code

<p><b>HEAD</b></p> <p>No caps, visors, hoods, bandanas or other head gear, except with administrative permission.</p> <p>Sunglasses are permitted.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ACCEPTABLE</b></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NOT ACCEPTABLE</b></p> 
<p><b>UPPER GARMENTS</b></p> <p>All garments must cover shoulder to shoulder. No rips/tears or skintight items.</p> <p>All garments must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline or stay tucked.</p> <p><b>NO</b> halter tops, tanks tops, spaghetti straps or muscle shirts.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ACCEPTABLE</b></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NOT ACCEPTABLE</b></p> 
<p><b>LOWER GARMENTS</b></p> <p>Undergarments and the buttocks <b>MUST</b> remain entirely covered even while seated.</p> <p>Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length.</p> <p>No rips/tears or skintight items.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ACCEPTABLE</b></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NOT ACCEPTABLE</b></p>
