Please be aware of the following opportunities on our campus **during the month of July**. Contact **Mr. Clark at extension 37807** for more information about these summer opportunities.

- **Algebra EOC Camp: July 8- July 24, 8:00AM to 11:30AM**  
for students who have not passed the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement
- **Biology Jump Start: July 1 – July 10, 8:00AM to 11:00AM**  
for students who will take Biology 1 next school year. This is an interactive experience that concludes with students visiting the outside classroom located at Rose Bay.
- **Take an EOC: July 22-July 25. Please contact Mrs. Crooks at extension 37807 to sign up.**  
(Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, and US History) that you have **not taken or passed**.

Orientation for the 2019- 2020 school year is quickly approaching. This is an opportunity to pick up schedules, purchase lockers, and have your ID photo taken before school starts. All students are encouraged to attend.

**Freshmen orientation is Thursday, August 1, 2019 from 1pm to 4pm**

Park in the student parking lot and enter the Auditorium. Tickets will be distributed beginning at 12pm for afternoon orientation on your respective date. Students are called by ticket number (first come, first serve) to start the orientation process. This process may take up to 3 hours.

Please remember, if you are unable to attend on your assigned date, the items may be purchased the first week of school. Friends may not purchase items for you in your absence. Parents or another adult with written permission may attend orientation on your behalf, however no exception to protocol will be considered. If they are unable to stay for the duration of orientation (potential 3 hour wait), it is recommended that you procure your items the first week of school.

Students are required to wear black shorts and white t-shirts to PE class.

**Class of 2023**, this year, the first day of school is just for you! August 12<sup>th</sup> is Freshmen Only Day. This will allow you to “learn the ropes” or in our case, “the nest” before upperclassmen fill the halls. School will start at 8:30 am with students beginning the day in homeroom (*Homeroom lists will be posted around campus. Find the first three letters of your last name in alphabetical order and report to the room number listed*) The day will be filled with spirited activities providing the opportunity for our newest Hawks to become familiar with the campus, class schedules and general knowledge of Creek Life.

All current aspects of the dress code remain in effect. Students are to wear a white, orange, grey or black collared **polo-style shirt** or **oxford style button down shirt (no lace-up or drawstring closures)**. The pants, shorts, capris, skorts, or jumper are to be **navy blue, black** or **tan** (khaki). Black and blue denim (jeans) **long pants** are also acceptable. No rips tears, holes or frayed edges are permitted on any garments. **More detailed information** regarding the dress code is available on the school’s or district’s website.

One final note: A 2019-2020 student planner/agenda will be provided for freshmen students. These will be handed out on Freshmen Only day. There is no need to purchase one.
